Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2020-21 educational progress for the Shumate Middle School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact Mr. Eric Cassie for assistance.

For the 2020-21 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has three or more underperforming student subgroups. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

We have not been given one of these labels.

Shumate Middle School continues to work with parent and community support to reach and exceed the needs of each student. For the 2021-2022 school year, Shumate Middle School will continue to use researched based best practices to meet the needs of all students.

Addressing the needs of our Economically Disadvantaged students, which constitute our largest struggling subgroup, along with otherwise at risk learners will require a two stage approach, including; ongoing commitment to intense, focused, data-driven intervention services, along with increased support to help students utilize technology in order to more fully access learning opportunities.

Shumate staff will continue to take part in frequent MTSS data meetings in order to monitor our students' academic progress and strategically use NWEA and local common assessment data to pinpoint areas of need and focus targeted intervention services.

Every Shumate student is issued a computer at the beginning of each school year, with which teachers will continue to utilize tools such as Google Classroom, along with new curricular resources to enhance the needed support and rigor for every student. The use of technology extends instructional opportunities beyond the structure of the building and instruction beyond clock hours for every student, regardless of their ability to afford a device or adult assistance at home.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

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1. Students in the Gibraltar School District are assigned to the school in their neighborhood, with bussing provided as needed. Opportunities for intra-district and inter-district School of Choice are also available.
2. The School Improvement plan for Shumate Middle School is a multi-year plan that focuses on improvement in all subject areas. Our most recent submitted plan goes through 2023. Our focus will be on best practices that apply to all subject areas. We use NWEA/MAP, M-STEP and local assessments to determine our focus for each subject area. We meet as a School Improvement Team multiple times during the school year to progress monitor and make necessary changes.
3. Shumate Middle School serves 6th through 8th grade students.
4. The curriculum at Shumate Middle School is aligned with the Michigan State Standards for literacy and math and Grade Level Content Standards for science and social studies. Our Director of Curriculum collaborates with principals and teacher leadership committees to continuously revise and improve our instructional materials and practices. 5. Student achievement results on M-Step and PSAT testing may be found online at <http://www.mischooldata.org/>. In addition to standardized state testing, all students are assessed three times per year in Reading and Mathematics using the Northwest Educational Association MAP Assessment.
6. Parents of our 758 students are invited to parent teacher conferences annually, which are held each fall. We have attained 99% participation through personal face to face contact or phone conference over the past two years.

Shumate Middle School prides itself on the work it does within the school walls and with the community. We are encouraged by the growth we have seen in our students through the utilization of best practice teaching methods and the idea that we are a community of learners.
