Fall Sport Contest Guidelines

Per Executive Order and MHSAA Rules

The following protocols will be strictly followed for all spectator sports. They have been put in place by the MHSAA and the downriver league to protect our fans, athletes and coaches from the spread of Covid-19. Failure to comply will result in revocation of all future tickets.

- Every participant will be given **two tickets** in advance of their contest.
 - No one under 18 will be admitted unless they have a parent with them and THEIR OWN ticket.
 - o Only those holding a ticket from the Carlson Athletic department will be admitted.
 - There are NO EXTRA TICKETS. Your player will be given only two tickets.
- There will be no ticket sales of any kind. If you do not hold a ticket to the game, please stay home. Varsity sports will be live-streamed whenever possible. Check Carlson's Facebook page to find the link.
- Students will not be allowed to congregate on school property during games.
- Football gates will open 30 minutes before kickoff; all other sports will open 15 minutes prior to the start of the contest
- There will be **NO RE-ENTRY** allowed at any event. Those who leave will not be allowed back in.
- Concessions will not be available. Guests will be allowed to bring in their own sealed beverages and snacks.
 - Alcoholic beverages and smoking (including e-cigarettes) are strictly prohibited and will result in removal from the venue
- When an event has two contests in a row (i.e. JV game before the Varsity) at the same venue, the stands will be cleared out before the new group of ticketed fans will be allowed to enter. Failure to comply with district personnel will result in your removal from the venue and revocation of future tickets for your player.
- Masks must be worn at all times.
