

Gibraltar School District Contractor Requirements and Oversight

Gibraltar School District is a public body that owns and operates a regulated municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) that is located in an urbanized area and discharges stormwater into surface waters of the state.

Gibraltar School District is required to:

- Prohibit non-stormwater discharges into the MS4.
- Reduce the discharge of pollutants from operation and maintenance activities.
- Require contractors hired by the district to perform operation and maintenance activities to comply with the stormwater management program.
