Fall Sport Contest Guidelines Per Executive Order and MHSAA Rules

The following protocols will be strictly followed for all spectator sports. They have been put in place by the MHSAA and the downriver league to protect our fans, athletes and coaches from the spread of Covid-19. Failure to comply will result in revocation of all future tickets.

- Every student-athlete in football and volleyball will be given **two tickets** in advance of their contest.
 - No one under 18 will be admitted unless they have a parent with them and THEIR OWN ticket.
 - Only those holding a ticket from the Shumate Athletic department will be admitted.
 - There are NO EXTRA TICKETS. Your player will be given only two tickets.
- There will be no ticket sales of any kind. If you do not hold a ticket to the game, please stay home.
- Students will not be allowed to congregate on school property during games.
- Football gates will open 30 minutes before kickoff; Volleyball will open 15 minutes prior to the start of the contest
- There will be **NO RE-ENTRY** allowed at any event. Those who leave will not be allowed back in.
- Concessions will not be available. Guests will be allowed to bring in their own sealed beverages and snacks.
- When an event has two contests in a row (i.e. 7th grade game before an 8th grade game) at the same venue, the stands will be cleared out before the new group of ticketed fans will be allowed to enter. Failure to comply with district personnel will result in your removal from the venue and revocation of future tickets for your player.
- Masks must be worn at all times.
