Earlier this morning, immediately prior to the beginning of the school day, a Shumate staff member was alerted that there was a bullet in one of the hallways of the middle school. Shumate administration, in conjunction with the Gibraltar Police Department, quickly determined that it was placed there by a student. The student who placed the bullet was immediately brought to the office where it was determined that there was no weapon or other gun paraphernalia on the student. After investigating, we were able to affirm that there was never any threat to the safety and security of our students, staff, and school.

We strongly urge parents to remind their students that there is no place for hunting or shooting paraphernalia, nor are these acts considered funny or a joking matter, as these acts have the potential to cause undue stress and fear on the entire school population. Acts such as this will always be taken seriously and will be prosecuted to the fullest extent possible of the law.
